
SPECIAL EVENT PARKING

Special Event parking passes are issued at <u>NO</u> charge and there is no limit on the number of passes issued for that specific date.

The City must receive one-week notice to issue Special Event parking passes, with the exception of immediate family emergencies (i.e. death in the family).

ENFORCEMENT

All vehicles in affected neighborhoods will be required to display a valid parking permit at all times. Failure to do so will result in a parking citation. All other restrictions pertaining to parking enforcement still apply (i.e. street sweeping, 72-hour trailer parking).

PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM

HOW TO OBTAIN AND RENEW PARKING PERMITS

Parking permits may be obtained at City Hall by presenting the *vehicle's registration*, provided the vehicle is registered at an address within the permit parking neighborhoods.

Resident parking permits must be renewed annually. The renewal period for the upcoming year begins after Nov. 1. All vehicles must display current parking permits by Jan. 1. City Hall will be closed for the holidays.

COST

Resident Parking Permits:

Residents are eligible to receive the first 2 parking permits at <u>NO</u> cost. Residents may purchase up to 2 additional resident permits for \$25.00 each. A maximum of 4 resident permits will be issued per household.

Guest Parking Permits:

Each household will be eligible for 2 guest parking permits. The first guest parking permit will be issued for \$5.00 and the second will be issued for \$25.00.

TEMPORARY PERMITS


In instances where a household has purchased a new vehicle, temporary permits may be issued for \$25.00. Residents must bring their temporary vehicle registration papers to City Hall to obtain a temporary permit. A refundable \$10.00 deposit will also be required for a temporary permit, to be returned when the temporary permit is returned to City Hall.

Temporary permits may be exchanged for a permanent resident parking permit within 90 days. The temporary permit fee will then be applied to the resident permit cost. In this case, the temporary permit fee will be refunded only if a household does not currently have more than 1 resident permit. If a household opts not to convert a temporary permit into a resident permit, the temporary permit fee is not refundable.

Lost temporary permits will be charged a replacement fee of \$25.00.

WHERE TO PLACE PARKING PERMIT ON VEHICLE

Resident parking permits must be placed in the back of the vehicle on the left side of the bumper.



Guest and temporary parking permits must be hung from the rear view mirror and visible at all times.
